ORCHESTRA POLICIES

REHEARSALS

Rehearsals take place once a week after school 3:45pm until 4:30pm. Instrument instruction and rehearsal time will be divided into smaller groups.

Rehearsals will take place in the music classroom, located in the second portable classroom outside of the gymnasium. **Please pick up your child promptly at 4:30pm**.

Tuesday: Violin and Viola Wednesday: Cello and Bass

After <u>3</u> unexcused absences, a student's name will be removed from the orchestra list and they will not be considered a member of orchestra.

Examples of unexcused absences include:

Forgetting

Not following the Ridgely Elementary School Code of Conduct during rehearsal

Examples of excused absences include:

- Absent from school (sickness, coming in late, etc.)
- Making up work, tests, etc. from classroom teacher (with documentation from the teacher)

BOOKS AND MUSIC STANDS

You must purchase the book *Essential Elements* 2000. I highly recommend the purchase of a music stand for home practice. It is essential for correct playing position.

PRACTICE

To experience success in musical performance, musicians must practice consistently! I recommend a *minimum* of four days of practice each week. Students are given a practice chart to record their daily practice. It is the student's responsibility to fill in the chart each day. Parents sign the chart at the end of each practice week. *Parents must be prepared to enforce regular practice habits!*

PERFORMANCE

Concert performance gives students the opportunity to share their music with family, friends and fellow musicians. Our winter and spring concerts are wonderful celebrations of each student's achievements! All orchestra members are required to attend two evening performances (one performance each semester). Please check your calendars carefully! Sporting events, dance rehearsals, etc. are not excused absences from the performance.
